## PROJECT BACKGROUND

The small but elegant Belfield House at Wyke Regis in Weymouth was built around 1780 to the designs of John Crunden (1740 - 1828) for the Buxton Family. It is a local example of the Palladian style, with a neat plan based on geometric forms. Incorporating modern technologies such as underfloor heating into Grade II\* listed properties can often be a challenge due to higher heat losses and older style floor constructions, however UFHN have vast experience and expertise in this area and were able to design and install a suitable system for the restoration project.
